

## Modi urges Maoists, J&K, N-E militants to join mainstream

Appealing to militants in the North-East, Jammu and Kashmir and Maoists to leave arms and join the national mainstream, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday said they can get nothing by following the path of violence.

"I tell the Naxalites, those in the North-East and Kashmir, who still have faith in bombs, guns and pistols, to learn from the Bodo youths, take inspiration from them and come to the mainstream. Live your life, celebrate life," Modi said, addressing a huge gathering here in celebration of the third Bodo peace accord inked late last month.

Welcoming the Bodo accord, the prime minister said he was aware that people of diverse groups live in Assam with their distinctive culture, language, dress and food habits.

"I am fully aware of your aspirations, pains and sorrows. The way Bodos have come together, I am confident that the misgivings of other communities will end fast. Have faith in your friend (Modi)."

### No 'danda' will work, I'm protected by people's blessings: PM

Yet again taking a dig at Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's 'danda' jibe targeting him, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday said that sticks cannot harm him as he is protected by the 'armour of blessings' provided by the mothers and sisters of this country. Modi, without naming Rahul Gandhi, said, "At times people talk of beating me with danda (stick). But when Modi is protected by the armour of blessings provided by so many mothers and sisters, whatever be the number of sticks rained on me, nothing will happen. 'You have come to embrace me... this has increased my confidence,' he said while addressing a rally during the 3rd Bodo Peace Accord celebrations here, about 216 km from state capital Guwahati.

In an indirect appeal to the banned United Liberation Front of Assam and its fugitive chief Paresh Barua, Modi said: "I appeal to those still nurtur-

ing some inimical thoughts regarding the country to shun such thoughts and come to the mainstream of development and take part in 'sab ke sath, sab ke vikas' (development for all). "Violence doesn't lead you to any goals, nor will it get you anything in future," he said.

## NIA quizzes IIT prof for 4th time over violence during anti-CAA protests

**GUWAHATI:** The National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Friday interrogated IIT-Guwahati professor Arupjyoti Saikia for the fourth time in a week in connection with the violence during the protests against the CAA here last month. Saikia, a professor of History at the Indian Institute of Technology-Guwahati, was summoned to the NIA office in Sonapur in the outskirts of the city. "Today he was questioned for several hours.

## MINI-REFERENDUM

Delhi election is not about AAP versus BJP; it is about how much importance citizens attach to development and issues of governance

It has been a high decibel slugfest to claim the Delhi 'takht', an election campaign that has veered from the absurd to the shrill with Shaheen Bagh protest taking centre stage and governance issues being relegated to the rear - almost diminished to a cameo role in the poll narrative, somewhat like the Congress.

The highly polarised election also brought the political discourse to a new low with obnoxious jibes like "desh ke gaddaro ko, goli maaro salon ko" being the norm. Even an innocuous word like 'biryani' became politically loaded in the vitiated atmosphere with the 'shootings' at Shaheen Bagh capturing the optics. To that extent, the triangular contest is not as much about conflicting ideologies as about a referendum on the Citizenship Amendment Act.

The Election Commission has played the impassioned and detached leg umpire and kept serving notices to all

and sundry to create a level playing field. Even on Friday, a day before the voting, the EC was on its toes and served a notice on CM Kejriwal for posting a video wherein he had claimed that rival parties and media channels dedicated to them are more interested in playing communal politics, while the AAP government wants to ensure the city's all-round development.

The EC said that it is "prima facie" of the view that the video, which has the "potential to disturb communal harmony," was a violation of the Model Code of Conduct. The CBI, too, had upped the ante the previous day by arresting a Delhi government officer, said to be the Officer on Special Duty to Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia, in an alleged bribery case of Rs 2 lakh. The BJP and the AAP have primarily been trying to occupy the political space vacated by the Congress and eyeing its traditional voters.



### CALL ON KIDS AT PROTESTS:

The court has taken cognisance on its own to "stop involvement of children and infants in demonstrations and agitations in view of death of an infant on January 30 at Shaheen Bagh." Recently, a 12-year-old National Bravery Award winner wrote to the Chief Justice seeking directions to prevent children from participating in demonstrations as it "amounts to cruelty".

### ANOTHER FIRING

Two bike-borne men allegedly opened three rounds of fire in the air near an anti-Citizenship Amendment Act protest site in northeast Delhi's Jafraabad on Friday, but the police said it appeared to be a fallout of personal enmity and not related to the stir over the contentious law. No one was injured in the incident.

## Tushar Gandhi event cancelled

**MUMBAI:** Mahatma Gandhi's great-grandson, Tushar Gandhi, has alleged that buckling under pressure from a Hindutva outfit, the Modern College of Arts, Science and Commerce in Pune cancelled his lecture scheduled on Friday as part of a seminar on Mahatma Gandhi.

The college authorities said that although the seminar went ahead as per schedule, Tushar Gandhi's speech was cancelled after some students threatened that they would stage a protest if he came to the event. The authorities also said that the cancellation was aimed at ensuring that nobody makes a political statement during the event. Condemning the episode, state housing minister Jitendra Awhad tweeted, "Not allowing Tushar Gandhi to speak because some Gandhi haters objected is ridiculous and should be condemned. The Pune police should not have allowed this to happen, it's unfortunate."

## In a rare move, word from PM's speech expunged in Rajya Sabha

In a rare move, a word from Prime Minister Narendra Modi's speech in Rajya Sabha was expunged from records.

Rajya Sabha Chairman M Venkaiah Naidu expunged the word used by Modi on Thursday during his reply to the discussion on a motion thanking the President for his address to the joint sitting of both Houses of Parliament at the start of the Budget session. "Chairman was pleased to direct expunction of a certain portion of the proceedings of Rajya Sabha dated February 6 at about 6.20 and 6.30 pm," a statement issued by the Rajya Sabha Secretariat

said. Naidu routinely expunges any remark found unsuitable from Rajya Sabha's records after going through the proceedings of the day. This has been done on several occasions but rarely was any remark of Modi expunged.

Modi had made the remark as he launched a strong defence of the NPR saying the country's popu-

lation register was being updated with demographic information for better targeting of government's welfare schemes. He had targeted the opposition Congress for making a U-turn, saying the party had brought the NPR in 2010 and was later updated in 2015 by adding photographs and some biometric information.

## Outrage over Pakistan court ruling allowing men to marry underage girls

Men in Pakistan can marry underage girls in accordance with Sharia law as long as they have had their first menstrual cycle, a high court in the country has ruled. The verdict has triggered outrage among many on social media.

The Sindh High Court in Karachi on February 3 gave the ruling in the case of 14-year-old Huma Younus, a Catholic girl who was abducted, forcibly converted and married off to a Muslim adult in October 2019. Her parents went to the police and the court seeking justice in the matter. A well-known Pakistani journalist, Naila Inayat, had last year quoted Huma's mother Nagina Younas as saying, "Should Christian mothers kill their daughters if conversion and kidnapping is their fate in Pakistan?"

## Kathua gang-rape & murder: SC stays JJB proceeding against juvenile

**NEW DELHI:** In a major development in gang-rape in Kathua, the Supreme Court on Friday stayed the proceedings before the Juvenile Justice Board against a "minor" involved in the case. The order by a bench headed by Justice N.V. Ramana and comprising Justices Ajay Rastogi and V. Ramasubramanian came as the administration contended before it that the High Court had made an error by affirming the order of the trial court, which upheld the accused as a juvenile at the commission of the offence in 2018.

## nCoV takes toll on biz in state

According to 2018-19 government report exports to China were valued at \$16.8 billion while import stood at \$70.3 billion. Several Chinese companies, including one engaged in heavy equipment manufacturing, based at Pitampura have put expansion plan on hold. Two Chinese nationals who came for company work to Mandasaur have been kept in a hospital in New Delhi for the last one week.

The police was probing what prompted them to end their lives, inspector Singh added. Kumar was posted in Ujjain. Both he and the woman hailed from Resham Mill locality of Gwalior, the official said.

## Chattarpur SDM plotted...

The police have also seized a live cartridge, baseball bat and two lathis. The SP said that since day one the police was suspicious of the entire incident. The forensic evidence confirmed their doubts. Later, phone call details brought the conspiracy to the fore. He said that the SDM, Pushpendra Singh and Javed Akhtar were good friends. Pushpendra has a business rivalry with Bhadoria. In the past, the SDM had initiated action against Bhadoria under 'drive against mafia' for the benefit of Pushpendra. However, Bhadoria got relief from the court. After the bid to frame Bhadoria failed, the accused hatched another plan. The SP said that as per the plan, Pushpendra and Akhtar arranged four attackers who ransacked SDM's office and ran away.

## Shankaracharya sees red...

The seer who is based in this Madhya Pradesh town said that the Supreme Court has in four rulings refused to acknowledge Vasudevanand as Shankaracharya. "If Shankaracharya was really to be associated with the trust he should have been named to preside over the trust instead of Parasaran, the advocate for Ramjanmabhoomi land case. He has been made the office of the chairman of the trust and his residence. Parasaran is a senior advocate of the country and a Jurist of repute... The government seems to be keen to build the Ram temple in Ayodhya as per the secular constitution and not according to Vedic provisions," he said in a statement.

Shankaracharya said a Ramalaya Trust was formed in the 1990s for the construction of Ram temple in the confluence of the four Shankaracharyas, which included other representatives including Shankaracharyas, Vaishnavacharyas, representatives of the Akharas. This trust was built for the construction of Ram temple in Ayodhya but the Central government has ignored a working trust while setting up a new trust, he said.

Swami Swaroopanand said a Scheduled Caste person included in the trust belongs to the Vishwa Hindu Parishad. Besides, some officials have been appointed by the government, in gross violation of the Constitution. Any trust that includes a government functionary who cannot be responsible for the construction of a shrine, he contended. Former Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh, Uma Bharati, who belongs to the Lodhi caste wants an OBC member in the trust. Former Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, Kalyan Singh, is also a contender as an OBC. He was the Chief Minister when Babri Mosque was pulled down.

## 75-90% decline in leopard population in India

Leopard population has declined 75-90 per cent in India, according to a study which has suggested that the carnivore demand similar conservation attention like tigers in the country.

The study was conducted by scientists from the Centre for Wildlife Studies (CWS India) and the Wildlife Institute of India. The scientists have used genetic data from leopards sampled across the Indian sub-continent to investigate population structure and patterns of demographic decline, a CWS India press release said. They investigated the

demographic history of each identified subpopulations and compared genetic decline analyses with countrywide local extinction probabilities. The study was conducted by Supriya Bhatt, Suvankar Biswas, Dr Bivash Pandav, Dr Samrat Mondol (all from Wildlife Institute of India) and Dr Krithi K Karanth (Centre for Wildlife Studies). They collected faecal samples and identified 56 unique individuals using a panel of 13 microsatellite markers, and merged this data with already available 143 leopard individuals. The study revealed population structure and recent decline in leopards.
